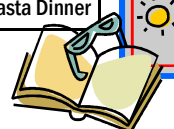

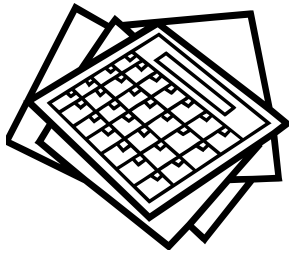


# 2010-2011 Calendar
