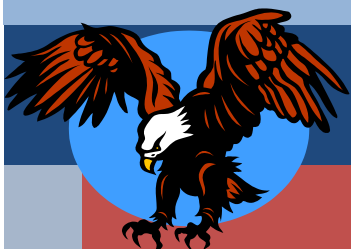

- They will experience, participate, and creatively express themselves through the arts.

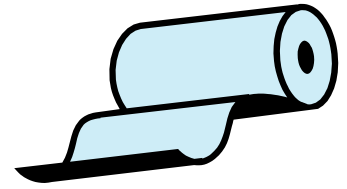
Critical thinkers

2018-2019 CONSUMABLE SUPPLY REQUEST



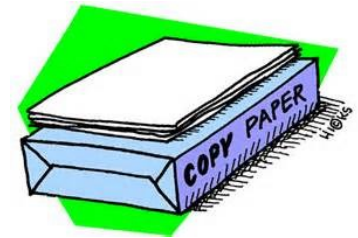
