### Speed and Comprehension Testing

I will be testing the students this week again on WPM (words per minute) and comprehension. The goal is to get them to 150WPM by the end of the Spring quarter. Many of them are already there or past it. I will also be sending

passages home for the parents to test them. Just put the timer on for 1 minute and have them read the passage. Circle words they mess up on and underline the word the word they stopped on. Then count how many words they read. This is great practice and helps the parents see where the students is in their reading skills.
