

Kindergarten Parents,

We are so excited to be back in school! The children have been enjoying learning school rules, how to take care of our classroom, and many other things. Below is some information that will help you and your child this school year. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us!

Backpacks: Please make sure your child comes to school with a backpack every day. We do a lot of fun things in kindergarten and this will help them carry all of their things home at the end of the day.

School Supplies: If you have NOT brought in your child's school supplies, please do as soon as possible. We are NOT allowed to share school supplies. If they do not have their school supplies, they will have to take their classwork home for homework. Please check the school website for the supply list.

Masks/Water bottles: Please make sure your child has a mask when they come to school. We MUST wear them when we are travelling around campus. When they are in the classroom, they can take them off. Also, every child needs to have a reusable water bottle. Due to coronavirus, all water fountains have been disabled. This will help keep them hydrated throughout the day.

Lunch/Snack: Parents are to send a lunch, morning snack, and afternoon snack. We are in school for a long time and get really hungry. Also, please make sure it is something your child can open. Due to coronavirus, we are unable to open items from your child's lunch.

Train Tickets: Each day your child will have an opportunity to bring home a "train ticket" for good behavior and good choices. Each child has a special envelope to keep their train tickets in. Once they have earned 25, they may bring them to school and go to the treasure box.

Homework/Missed Class Work: It is very important that homework assignment are completed neatly, correctly, and on time. This is an important tool in laying a strong foundation for future work habits. Homework will be sent home on Thursday's and is to be returned the next Friday (a week later). Students will have one week to complete the packet. We also encourage each child to read with their families for 10-20 minutes a night.

If your child misses a day of school, please make sure they complete their missed work at home and return it as soon as possible. If classwork is not return, it will reflect in their grade on report cards.

Folders: Your child's take home folder will go home on Thursday's and are to be returned on Friday (with homework from the previous week inside). Please check your child's folder every Thursday for notes, special announcements, corrected work, etc. Take all papers like this out and keep them at home.

Dismissal: Kindergarten is dismissed at 2:30 pm. If someone is picking up your child, please make sure they have their ID on them. We will check ID's before releasing them. If they are not on your child's pick-up list, please send in a signed note that states who they will be going home with.
