I can't believe we are almost done with the month of September! How the time has been flying by! This week in reading centers we learned the word 'like' and learned how to use it in a sentence. We also learned how to capitalize the first letter of our names and the first letter in a sentence. In math, we continue to work on patterns, sorting by color, graphing and how to properly write our numbers from 1-10. In bible, we learned about Abraham and Sarah.
