We had a great first week of school! Everyone is settling into our classroom routines nicely. It's hard to adjust to a full day of learning sometimes, but our students are doing a great job. This week we focused mostly on writing our names, writing numbers to 5 and reviewing letters. We started our Bible curriculum this week. We focused on creation and how we are created in God's image. We also started science this week. We started learning about animals and animal needs. We saw a video of a woodpecker, racoons and a quail and even got to pretend to be these animals! It was fun pretending to get our hands muddy like a raccoon. Next week we will start our math and ELA units.
