Hello families of all the wonderful third graders. We have been working hard in the classroom and will continue to do so. I know you have been working hard at home and together we will achieve great things.

We have had a few mishaps in communication, but that is all behind us. Also, I have seen some students having trouble using their planner. I do encourage you all to guide them in the importance of using the planner correctly. In class, we have implemented a new technique and I have already seen a great improvement. Please note that we do have homework every night (sometimes weekends), so if your child says he/she doesn't have homework, something is wrong. Be on the lookout for this. I really don't want to have them do it the next day, it keeps piling on if they don't complete it. Full credit is for homework on time.

We officially had our first test day this Friday. Do not fear, this is a normal part of the curriculum and they will have an English Language Arts Test (ELA) every Friday with a spelling test. Take note that other tests for Science, Social Studies and Math will be more sporadic, and are dependent on the curriculum. I will let you know in advance so you can prepare and aid your child.

That being said, Next week, students will have a small Science Quiz on Tuesday. Don't worry, there is nothing to study, we will cover the material on Monday.

We will review the material before every test and it's important that you remind your child to pay close attention in class.
