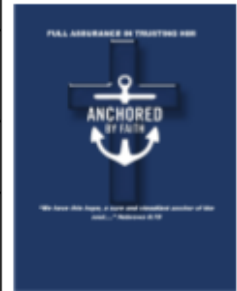

**Bible:** This week we completed Lessons 6 and 7 in our "One in Christ" textbooks. The bible verse for this week was: "Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped." - Isaiah 35:5

**Coming up:** We will be covering lessons 8,9, and 10 in class. The students will also receive a new bible verse on Tuesday to memorize by Friday.

**Homework:** Memorize this week's bible verse

**History:** The students received their Chapter 1 test back. If a student received a 70% or below they were required to get a parent signature along with test corrections All students were allowed to do test corrections and receive ½ a point for every answer they corrected. This week we also covered Chapter 2 Lessons 1-2 and the students worked on an in class project. In this project they created a large poster or a mural of California's first people.

**Coming up:** We will continue Chapter 2 and cover lessons 3-4. Students will take their Chapter 2 test on 9/15. On 9/9 students will take a benchmark test, testing them on the things they learned in social studies in previous years (this is not for a grade just a baseline test)

**Homework:** Complete the vocabulary worksheet to prepare them for Chapter 2 test. They will receive this on Wednesday 9/8.

**English:** This week students completed lesson 2 in their english books. They also had a packet complete for homework. They also received their spelling/vocabulary 2 back. Students who received a 70% or below are required to receive a parent signature and do test corrections. All students are allowed to do test corrections  $\frac{1}{2}$  a point for each correction made. We are also reading 'Charlotte's Web' as a class. Please be on the lookout for instructions for their book report project. They will be doing this after completion of the book. We are currently about  $\frac{1}{2}$  way through.

Reading logs are due Friday, and they will receive a new one on Fridays

**Coming up:** Students will work on lesson 3 and receive a packet for homework. They will also receive new vocabulary and spelling words to study for their test on Friday

**Homework:** Lesson 3 packet due 9/10. Study new spelling and vocabulary words for Friday 9/10

**Science:** This week we completed our "How to be a Scientist" brochure and completed lesson 4. This covered the scientific method.

**Coming up:** We will be completing unit 1 , completing lesson 5 and 6

**Homework:** Students will receive a unit review on Tuesday and it will be due 9/10

**Math:** This week students completed lessons 13-15. As well as doing their first math test. I will have these graded and returned to students on Tuesday. If a student receives a 70% or below they are required to get a parent signature and do test corrections. All students are allowed to do test corrections for  $\frac{1}{2}$  a point for each correction.

**Coming up:** We will be going over lesson 16-18 in class. After each lesson students will receive a worksheet or homework problems from the textbook. On Friday 9/10 students will take a benchmark test, testing them on math skills they have previously learned in the grades before (this is not for a grade, just to create a baseline for the rest of the year).

**Homework:** Lesson 16 #1-30 odd due 9/8 , Lesson 17 #1-30 even due 9/9, and lesson 18 #1-30 odd due 9/10
