

## 11/8-11/12

I'll be reaching out and informing you of some of the on-goings in music class through this newsletter (thanks Ms. Lunch for including me)!

This week we focused on getting our ukulele groove back by having students partnering up with one another (or working by themselves) to practice and prepare for their playing quiz/performance that's on Monday, November 8th. Students are encouraged to sing, strum, and change chords together! So that means if your student is strumming well but struggling with chord transitions, they should focus on learning the chords. Next week, I will be distributing an ukulele Christmas music packet so students should feel extremely confident with their chords (C, F, and G(7)) because we will be learning lots of new chords soon!

Since many 4th graders missed out last week on our Christmas musical tryouts, we held informal tryouts this past Wednesday. Thank you to those of you who auditioned! Mrs. Bakken and I will meet and discuss on Friday morning to assign roles so I hope to have an official list posted by the end of the day Friday.

Speaking of the Christmas show, our annual program will be held this year at the Vacaville Performing Arts Theater (VPAT) across the street from our school on Monday, December 13. Students are required to be there and participate unless parents write to me directly AHEAD of time with a legitimate excuse (i.e. sports practice will not be an excused absence). This is because it's imperative for all members of the group (in this case, our ukulele class and Christmas musical) to be there and many students rely on each other. I laid this out in the class syllabus but performances like this are counted as a "final project" assignment in their grades. That means if they're not there, they will not receive credit.
