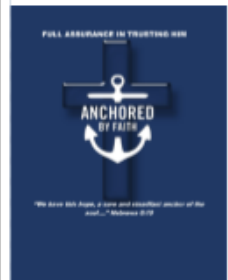
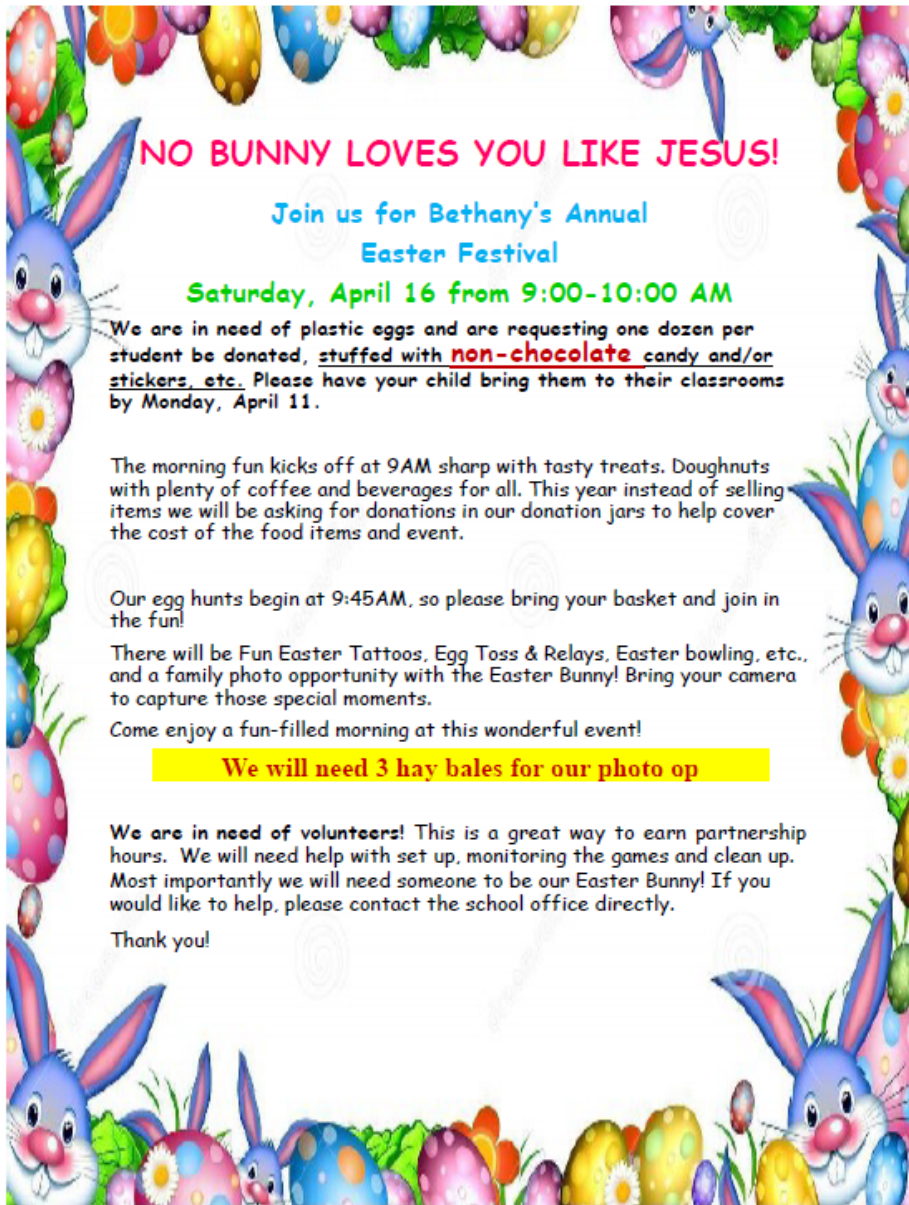

HISTORY

MATH

This week we completed lessons 81-84. We will continue with lessons 85 -88. We have moved past memorizing multiplication facts and now are memorizing basic division facts. **Please help your student memorize these facts at home as we will be testing weekly (not graded).** They will also complete practice test 15B as we did 15A together as a group.

Homework - Any lesson that is not completed in class will be homework. Each lesson we will take notes do the lesson practice and then complete 1-30. Practice division facts.

ENGLISH

We are now beginning lesson 15 in our Journey's books. We will complete the first read and introduce spelling and vocab words. Reading logs will be given out Monday and are due the

following Friday. Students should be reading a minimum of 30 minutes per day and reading at least a 4th-grade level chapter book. If you need a suggestion list, please reach out. We also are working through persuasive writing and learning and paragraph formats. This week we worked on our introduction paragraphs.

Homework - Prepare for spelling/vocab test. Any incomplete classwork will be homework.
