


ENGLISH

We are well into Lesson 15 in our Journey's textbooks and will begin the packet together in class this week. We will also work on grammar and writing techniques. Reading logs will be given out Monday and are due the following Friday. Students should be reading a minimum of 30 minutes per day and reading at least a 4th-grade level chapter book. If you need a suggestion list, please reach out. We also are working through persuasive writing and learning and paragraph formats. We have pieced together five complete paragraphs. The rough draft is due Wednesday, 3/30.
