BIBLE

Every Monday (or the first day of the school week) I will present the students with a short Bible verse to memorize. Every Friday, we will test on the memorization of the verse from that week.

This weeks verse is “Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.” - Hebrews 11:1

Along with the verse, we have a work book ‘ One in Christ’ each week in class, we will work together on the lessons. This upcoming week we will continue to work on lessons 4-7 as we work through the book of Genesis.

ENGLISH
