First Grade: In ELA, we learned about action verbs. We talked about many different action verbs and how we use them to describe an action. We continued to work on forming a complete sentence using capitalization and punctuation. In math, we are continuing to work on our numbers. We started working on telling time, counting coins, and angles of shapes. We will have a math test next Wednesday 9/21. Our bible stories this week were, Isaac Blesses His Sons, and Joseph. We talked about revenge and what that means. We also talked about forgiveness and repenting for our sins. In science, we learned how scientist work.
