This week we have been learning:

**Bible:** We discussed why we should pray, why we start worship with confession and absolution, and what sins we should confess and to who.

**Science:** We continued learning about how weather is predicted, how air masses form, how fronts affect weather, how meteorologists obtain and analyze weather data, and different types of severe weather. This concluded our weather unit.

**Math:** We learned about remaining fractions, two-step equations, multiplying three or more factors, exponents, polygons, and division with two-digit answers.

**History:** We learned about Ranchos and Pueblos, why Californians traded with U.S. ships, and the differences between life on a rancho and life in a pueblo.

**ELA:** We read "Sacagawea" and "Native American Nature Poetry," learned about main idea and details, text structure, onomatopoeia, visualization, abbreviations, shades of meaning, words with the VCCV pattern, and mastered new vocabulary and spelling words.
