This week we learned about indefinite pronouns and how they don't specifically identify what they are referring to such as: someone, somewhere, anything, etc. Our story this week was "A Butterfly Grows". In math, we are working on subtracting a number from 10 and our review subtraction facts. We also worked on word problems, place value, dividing in halves, thirds, and sixths, counting dimes and pennies, and telling time to half past a number. 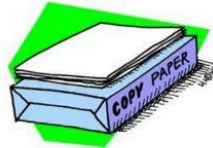
Consumables: Here is a list of the consumables. Please send them in when you can.
