**DONUT DAY! Donuts will be sold before school for \$1 by our Student Council!**

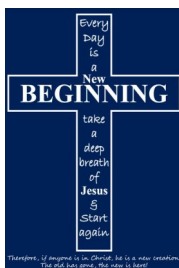
## Fiesta Dinner & Auction—Friday, May 3 @ 5pm

Between 8:15am-4pm you may come to purchase raffle tickets and place your ticket in the bag that corresponds with the basket you wish to try to win.



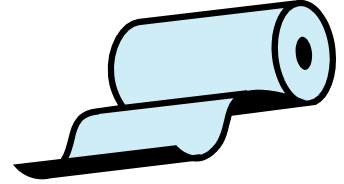

# 2023-2024 CONSUMABLE CLASS SUPPLY REQUEST



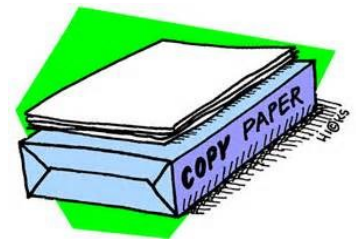
